**Description:** Interleukin  $1\alpha$  is a proinflammatory cytokine produced by

a wide variety of cell types, including macrophages, osteoblasts, monocytes and hepatocytes. Circulating levels of are normally low and only rise after stimulation by agents such as those produced by inflammation, infection or microbial endotoxins. IL-1  $\alpha$  possesses a wide variety of biological activities and exerts its effects by binding to

specific cell surface receptors.

**RANDOX** recombinant IL-1 $\alpha$ -chain comprises a 159 amino acid fragment (113-271) corresponding to the mature IL-1 $\alpha$  chain and is expressed in *E. coli* with an amino-terminal hexahistidine tag. This product is for research use only and is not intended for diagnostic or

therapeutic use.
